On behalf of our World Rivers Day founder and Chair, Mark Angelo, I wanted to let you know that anticipation is rapidly building for World Rivers Day 2024, set for Sunday, September 22 (as always, falling on the fourth Sunday in September) – it's now only 10 weeks away! As the world's largest celebration of rivers and the many communities and lifeforms they sustain, we wanted to reach out to you knowing that many of you are already developing plans. Please let us know of any activities you may organize!

Types of river festivities and events will vary greatly. As always, there will be our traditional physical events, such as stream clean-ups, stream-side planting and restoration efforts, educational outings, and community riverside celebrations. In addition, there are also many events of digital nature being planned so there will be an incredible diversity of events taking place across 6 continents!

While many of these will be profiled in the weeks ahead, today's WRD spotlight is on Italy's impressive WRD plans, where the renowned environmental organization, Piublu, is coordinating a major initiative with the theme, "Together we clean the rivers". This collective action will be carried out in collaboration with the European Parliament.

Piublu is a leading advocate for eliminating plastic pollution as well as protecting marine, lake and river ecosystems. The group is also committed to raising awareness among young people. They are **organizing large collective clean-up efforts along a number of waterways September 22**, preceded by an Institutional Round Table in Rome on the 20th of September focusing on the importance of collaboration in achieving the best results for our rivers.

On World Rivers Day across Italy, major cleanups will take place simultaneously on the **Tiber River in Rome, the Arno in Florence**, **the Po in Turin**, **and the Lago Patria north of Naples**, **among others**. These efforts will be done in collaboration with the Italian Federation of Rowing, along with the Federation of Canoeing and Kayaking, as well as the Dragon Boat Federation. There will also be extensive efforts to involve students.

For this event, Piublu enjoys the collaboration of the **European Parliament**, the patronage of the **European Commission**, along with the support of the **Ministry of the Environment and Energy Security**, **CONI** (Italian National Olympic Committee), ASVIS, Rome Capital, **Italian Federations of Rowing**, Canoeing and Kayaking, and Dragon Boating, the support of **WWF Italia**, Marevivo, Tevere day and the international partners **Goumbook** and the **Plastic Pollution Coalition**. **We congratulate Piublu on their efforts!**

We will profile many other events in future weeks - and by the time we get to September, activities will be planned across the globe. So please, let us know your WRD plans by filling out our event registration form! Clean fresh water has never been more important and World Rivers Day is a timely opportunity for millions of people worldwide to come together to celebrate the importance of healthy, vibrant waterways!
